### VISA Requirements:

Please check with immigration to ensure that you select the correct visa for your circumstances. A visa which may be suitable for your trip to Australia is the **ETA (Visitor) (Subclass 976)**. An ETA (Visitor) subclass 976 is designed for people who are outside Australia and want to visit Australia for holidays, tourism, and recreation or for informal study.
